## first cycle March/April 2010

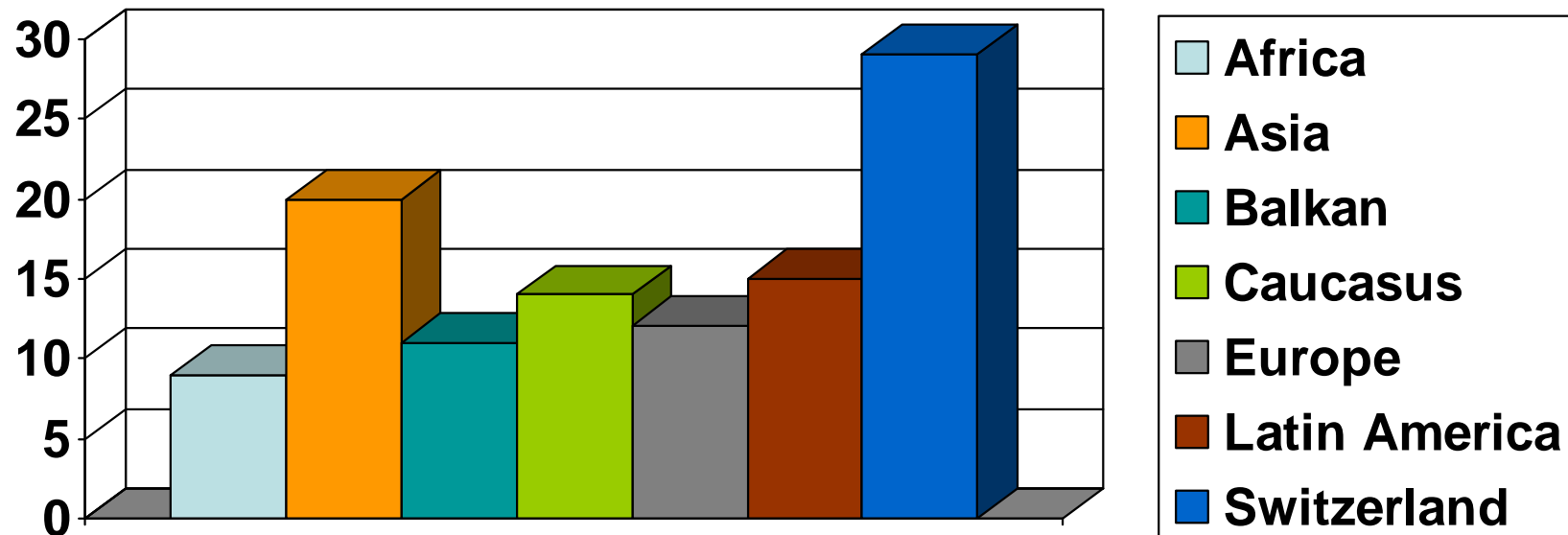
The objective of all e-learning cycles is:

**Topic cycle 1: Planning** – setting up a Value Chain or M4P program:

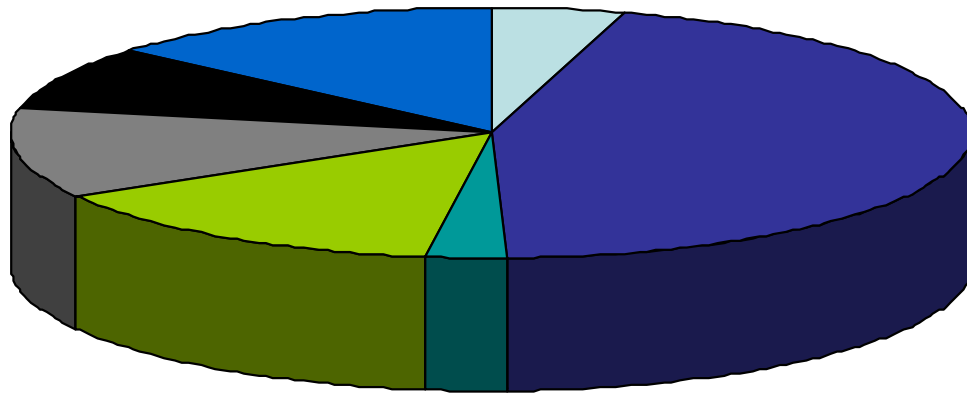
- What are the main aspects?
